1-Gal **Baby Kim Syringa**

Dwarf Pink Lilac grows to 24-36" tall and 36" wide. This delightfully fragrant lilac is the smallest lilac to date and packs in a lot of flower power. Deer and disease resistant. Dark green foliage, an abundance of fragrant purple blooms that don't fade to white.

1- Gal **Ringo Rosa**

Big, single, bright yellow flowers each have a bold red ring in the center for a dazzling visual effect in the landscape or garden. Dead-heading not required and disease resistant. Full Sun (6+ hours), Part Sun (4-6 hours), Full Shade (up to 4 hours). Mature Ht. 48" and 36-48"

1-Gal **Bloomerang® Dark Purple**

Big, bold and beautiful Bloomerang® lilac with months of blooms instead of just weeks. Disease and deer resistant. Mature size is 48-72" tall and 48-72" wide.

This hydrangea blooms every year, even in colder climates and impervious to bad pruning. It is much-like the Annabelle but instead of white blooms, the flowers are deep pink-mauve and they don't flop over. Blooms early and reblooms through the summer. Dwarf with 30-36" Ht. and Width.

A species of milkweed native to Michigan (*Asclepias tuberosa*). The color and nectar are a pollinator attractor. It is a host plant to the monarch butterfly. Grows 36-40" tall.

1- Gl. trade **Campanula Pearl Deep Blue**

This low-growing herbaceous bellefower perennial has long stems bearing solitary 2" wide bell-shaped vivid blue-violet flowers with lighter centers. Blooms spring to late summer if deadheaded regularly. Tolerates a wide range of conditions and spreads more compact than other Campanula. 8" tall and 12-24" spread.
